Non-fatal strangulation is not the same as choking or suffocating. Find out the possible effects of delayed care or no care at all.

Accurate assessment and treatment after a non-fatal strangulation can prevent permanent injury or delayed death of the victim.

Often victims of non-fatal strangulation are at an increased risk of homicide.

South Carolina is working on making non-fatal strangulation a stand-alone felony and is one of the last states in the nation to do so.
